QUALIFICATION DESCRIPTION	<p>This qualification reflects the role of individuals in the community, home or residential care setting who work under supervision and delegation as a part of a multi-disciplinary team, following an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason.</p> <p>These individuals take responsibility for their own outputs within the scope of their job role and delegation. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.</p> <p>To achieve this qualification, the candidate must have completed at least 120 hours of work as detailed in the Assessment Requirements of the units of competency.</p> <p>No licensing, legislative, regulatory or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.</p>
ENTRY REQUIREMENTS	There are no entry requirements for this qualification.
